Covered Bridge Sheard's Mill Quakertown, PA 18951 (about 20 min away)

Constructed in 1873, by unknown builders, Sheard's Mill Covered Bridge spans Tohickon Creek. One of Bucks County's longer bridges, it is 130 ft long and 15 ft wide. The one span bridge uses the Town Truss and is painted the traditional red with a white entry, or portal. Many covered bridges were built near mills for the convenience of farmers. In this situation, the mill was built by David Sheard in 1835 and is still standing. During the 20th century, John Clymer owned the mill and continued to grind grain for feed and apples for cider until 1965. The mill, is on the National Register and currently part of the Tohickon Family Campgrounds. From Rt 313 and Rt 563 (Mountain View Dr, which runs on the north side of Lake Nockamixon), go east for 0.9mi. Turn left onto Sterner Rd. Go 325 ft and take the first right onto Richlandtown Rd and go 1.2 mi. Take the first right onto Covered Bridge Rd 0.5 mi.

Tom Raub and Al Seiders comments in RED (and Al's rating scale with 10 best) or at end of address. Really detailed comments are not needed for the Quakertown ones (i.e. Ernie Alich and I are unsure as to which ones are currently open or not open but it doesn't matter because they are all within 10 minutes or 5 miles from where you will be. As for Adamstown, it is the top place to go especially on Sundays and no detailed descriptions are needed because if someone is driving the hour to Adamstown they can just go up and down Route 272 (not 222) and hit all the shops to their hearts content. The northern-most one is Pine Hills (bad) and the southern-most is Mother Tuckers (not very good either). I would also add Slatington Antiques...about an hour north of Quakertown but worth going to.
