I would like to feature a collector of the month in every JFO. If you want to be featured, send me some pictures of your collection and your life history and I will use it.

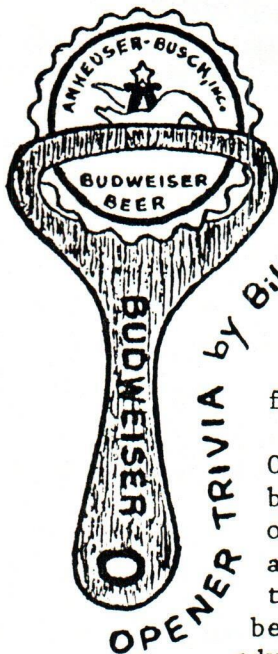
The following article will be of interest to the members who attended the St. Louis Convention. On our tour of St. Louis, we stopped at this Brewery. A fire that destroyed a mostly vacant row of buildings in the 3600 block of Forest Park Ave. on Jan. 1 was deliberately set, authorities said. The buildings were at one time a Falstaff brewery complex. "Our laboratory tests have provided positive proof that an accelerant had been poured in there," said Cept. Ron Gronemeyer, chief investigator for the Fire Dept.

OPENER TRIVIA by Bill McKenzie

It has become increasingly more popular to collect "soda" and "pop" memorabilia. "Coca-Cola" and "Pepsi-Cola" are by far the most common brands collected and some items command prices which equal and often exceed those of rare breweriana pieces. "Dr. Pepper" is also popular among collectors, but there is only a limited amount of advertising available for this brand. For most other brands even less advertising exists, and for that reason they are very seldom collected by themselves but rather as part of the whole.

Some collectors specialize in a particular flavor of soda regardless of the brand name. The most popular flavors seem to be cola and root beer, and they usually collect anything and everything advertising their favorite flavor.

Other collectors specialize in collecting particular items such as cans, bottles, signs, or openers. Cans are probably the most popular with openers somewhere down the list. I believe the main reason that soda advertising openers are not more popular is because there is nowhere near the abundance and variety of soda advertising openers that exists for beer advertising openers. Even then there are some very nice soda advertising openers, a few types of which do not exist for beer advertising openers.

Illustrated on the following page are a few soda advertising openers. The notes which follow are in reference to those openers:

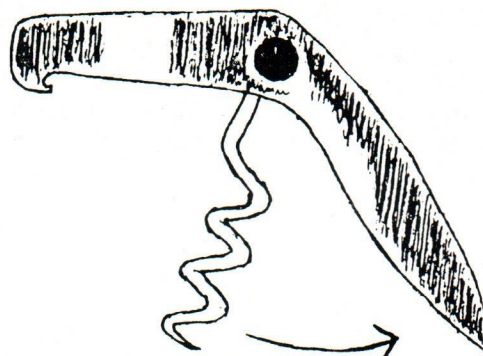
- ① an A-12 type Coca-Cola opener.
- ② the reverse side of opener ①.
- ③ an unusual ladies leg figural opener; the only brand I have ever seen it in is "Nehi"; reverse side is blank.
- ④ a side view of opener ⑤.
- ⑤ an unusual opener-spoon-corkscrew; this is the only one I have seen with or without advertising; I wonder what the teeth at the end of the spoon were used for?
- ⑥ reverse side is blank.
- ⑦ a "Pepsi-Cola" opener-muddler; much desired by "Pepsi" collectors this particular version is valued at more than \$50.00.
- ⑧ reverse side is blank except for design.
- ⑨ reverse side reads: DEBORAH GINGER ALE
- ⑩ usual obverse design with bone-handled corkscrew and glass of beer; PATD. MAR 12 - 1912
- ⑪ marked: PAT. PEND. B. & B. ST. PAUL; considering how scarce this type is to find in either beer or soda I do not think it ever was patented (?).
- ⑫ reverse side is the same as the obverse except without the words "Coca-Cola".

Most of the drawings in this issue were drawn from photostatic copies of the openers. If you have unusual or interesting openers and corkscrews that you would like me to include in Opener Trivia all I need is a good clear photostatic copy of them. From the copy I should be able to make a reasonably accurate drawing.

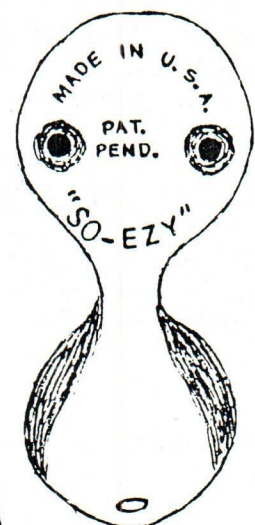

ED. NOTE: It is listed in the "Canadian Beer Advertising Openers" book as a CC-11-1.

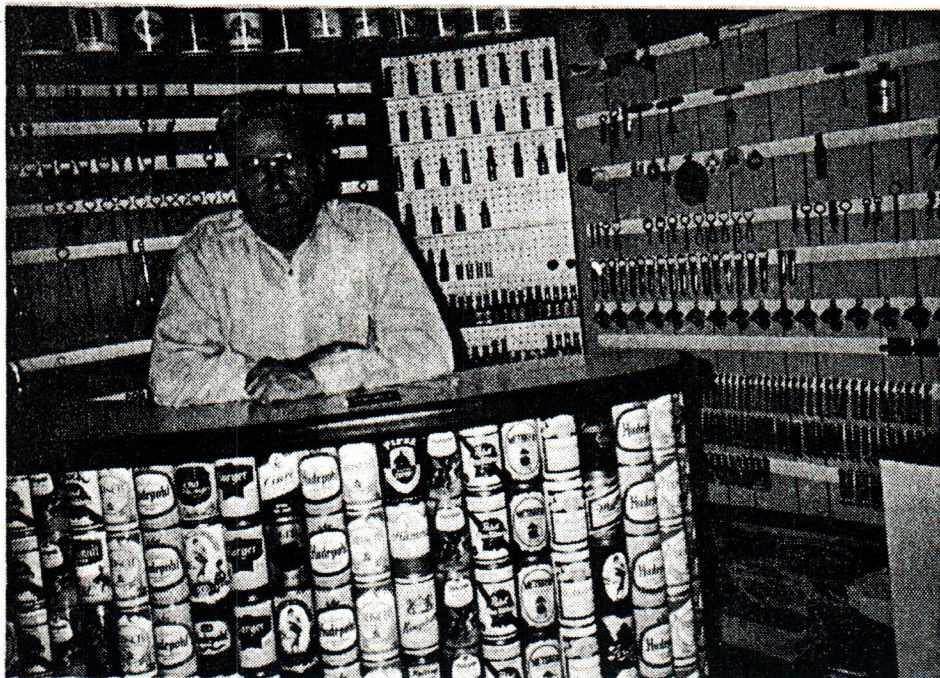

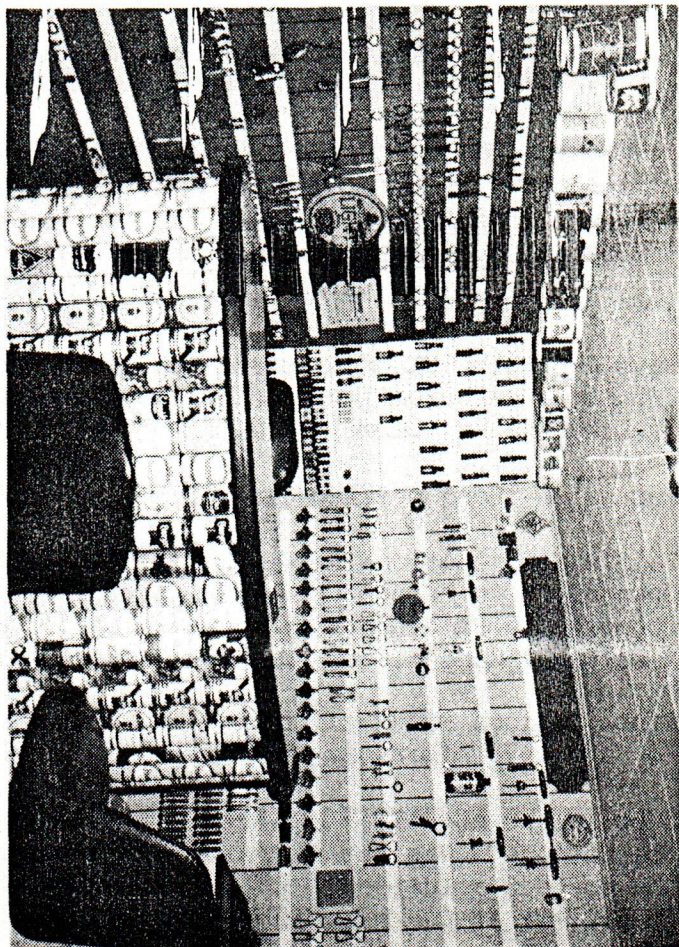
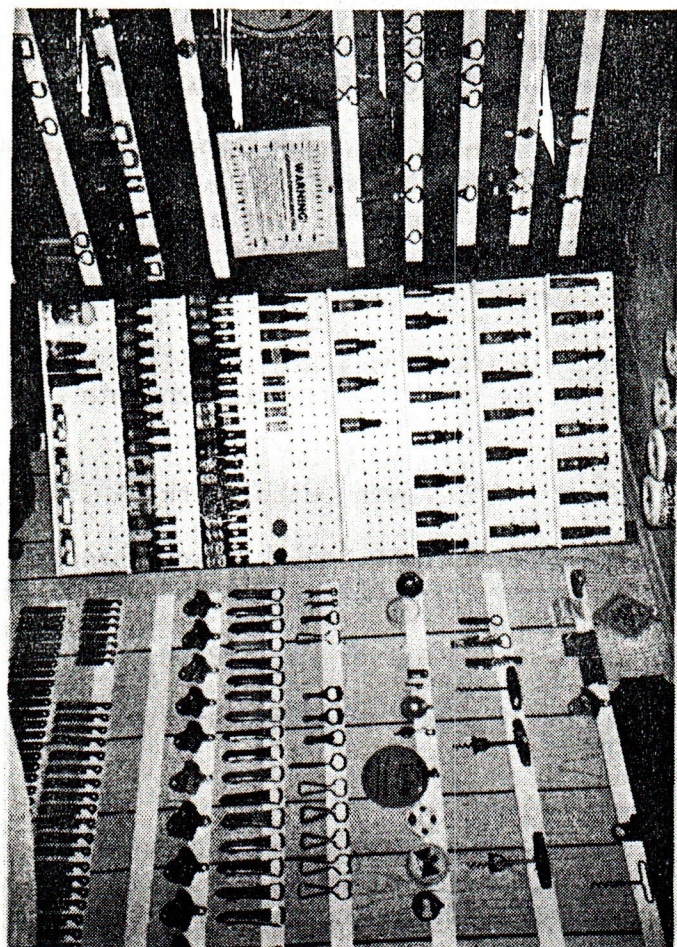
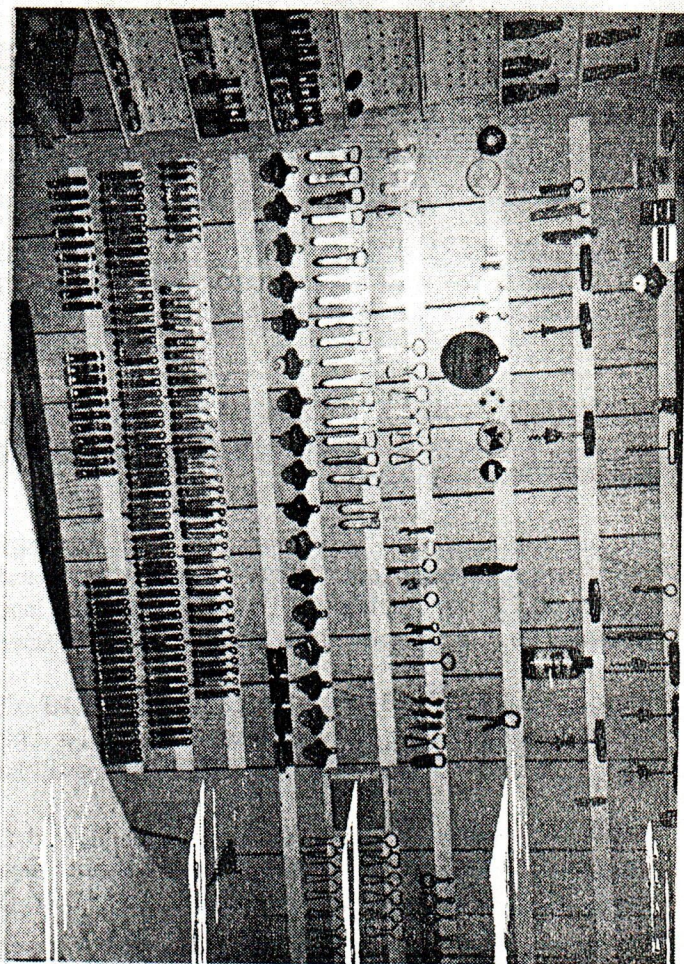
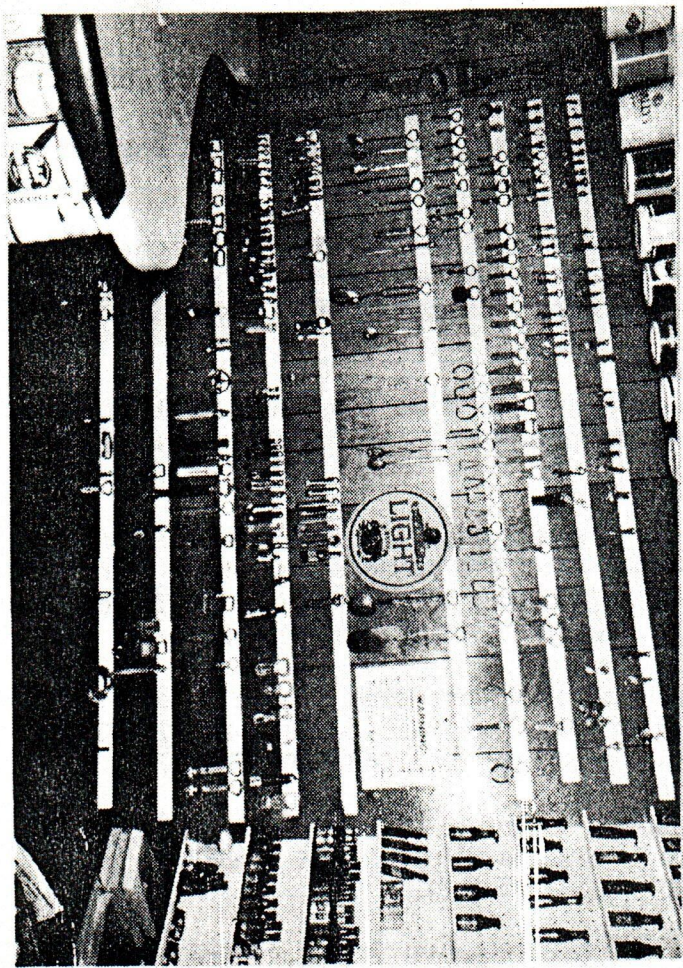
### JOE CARDONE
