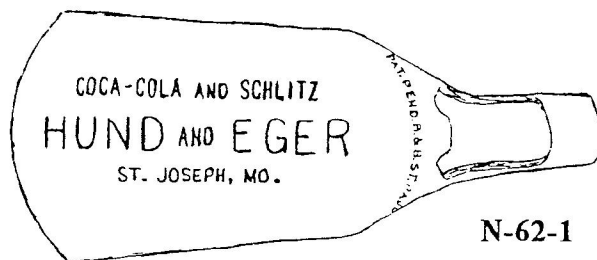

## **Opener Trivia Returns with Bill McKenzie**

Bill McKenzie did a lot of super articles on "Opener Trivia" from 1986 to 1993. Due to health problems he had to give up his outstanding contribution to the newsletter. Bill's health has greatly improved and through his efforts an extremely nice article on the Hund & Eger Bottling Company appears in the following pages. After the article is a menu ad for Goetz Country Club Beer. Goetz was brewed in St. Joseph and this menu was one of the advertisements by the Goetz Brewing Company. Bill says it is a beautiful ad and unfortunately the black and white picture does not do it justice. Bill adds the following paragraph about the Goetz menu picture.

St. Joseph is famous for being the starting point of the Pony Express. The service, which ran cross country westward to Sacramento, California, lasted only from April 3, 1860 to October 24, 1861. The Goetz Brewing Company founded in 1859 chose the theme of a pony express rider and the slogan "Famous Since The Days of THE PONY EXPRESS" to advertise their beer. The beautiful cowgirl on their menu cover is another example of their use of western art.

## THE HUND &amp; EGER BOTTLING COMPANY of ST. JOSEPH, MO.

In honor of the 1995 JFO Convention in St. Joseph I thought it would be interesting to do an article on the Hund & Eger Bottling Company. My special thanks goes to Don Whelan, our convention host, who researched the history of the company and sent me pictures of the openers in his collection plus the photocopies of the ads from the city directories. Without his help it would have been impossible to do justice to this article.

The Hund & Eger Bottling Company is of special interest to both collectors of beer and soda advertising openers. Seldom will you find a bottling company that issued more than one or two openers. Seldom has a bottling company chosen such desirable and unusual types to advertise their business and products. Seldom will you find a bottling company that was an agent for three different brewers. Seldom do you find a bottling company with a name other than Coca-Cola Bottling Company that is a bottler and distributor of Coca-Cola. Seldom, if ever, was there a bottling company as unique as the Hund & Eger Bottling Company.

The history of the Hund & Eger Bottling Company dates back to 1882, the year the company was founded by William Hund and Louis Eger. Like most bottling companies of that era they bottled their own brand of soda water and also other brands such as Orange Smile and Green River. In 1905 they became the franchise bottler and distributor of Coca-Cola for St. Joseph and most of the counties in Northwest Missouri. In that same year they also became agents for the Pabst Brewing Company. Openers number ① ③ & ⑥ (illustrated) all date before 1919, the year that prohibition began.

During the first few years of prohibition Hund & Eger continued to be agents for Pabst non-beer products. Then for some reason around or before 1924 they switched and became agents for the Goetz Brewing Company. If you refer to the ads from the 1932 and 1933 city directories (illustrated) you will see that they continued to be agents for Goetz Country Club until 1933, the year that prohibition was repealed. Studying the listings for types A-21, F-29, and N-62 I would guess that openers number ② ⑤ & ⑦ (illustrated) might be from the prohibition era.

The city directory for 1934 was not available, but the city directory for 1935 advertises Hund & Eger as "Agents for Schlitz". It is my belief that when prohibition ended there was a lot of competition among brewers to lure bottlers to be the agent for their products. You will notice that in the 1935 city directory (illustrated) there were three bottlers in St. Joseph, two of which distributed Goetz Beer. Schlitz needing an agent in the area probably made Hund & Eger an offer they couldn't refuse. Openers number ④ & ⑧ (illustrated) date somewhere after prohibition up until 1954. In 1955 their advertisement no longer included Schlitz.

In closing I would like to say that I am uncertain as to when the Hund & Eger Bottling Company ceased operations. If you know anything more about the company or have any openers that are not illustrated I would like to hear from you. I will try to include any information I receive in a future issue of JFO.

Please use the following guidelines when using these prices:

- 1) **Condition** Prices are for openers in at least excellent condition.
- 2) **Scarcity** Openers with the highest prices are generally the hardest to find openers especially in nice condition. Several types have few examples known and this is reflected in the price.
- 3) **Demand** Malt companies or the more common brewery names are at the low end. Small breweries or breweries in business for a short time bring the highest value. Also certain areas of the country have more collectors looking for openers from that area (Ex: Missouri or Pennsylvania).

### "OPENER/CORKSCREW ACQUISITIONS"

Ben and Cornelia Hoffman visited with Pat and myself in Mid-January. Ben has accumulated a lot of really nice openers with special emphasis on Pennsylvania and M-3 Slide-Out openers. They arrived Friday afternoon and stayed until Sunday morning. Ben brought along about 100 openers that were new additions, corrections, new discoveries or openers needing verification of the listing shown currently in the 1994 Handbook.

Ben and I started Friday evening going through the openers he brought. By Saturday evening I had found 4 "New Discoveries", 37 "New Additions and 25 "Corrections". Ben had spent the fall transferring his collection list to the 1994 Handbook and had come up with these discrepancies in the mentioned categories. Saturday was spent at the Greensboro Flea Market, 4 different Antique Malls and 7 Antique Shops. A couple of cheap openers and a few "swizzle sticks" for Cornelia was all that we turned up. Ben commented on how little "Breweriana" he saw.

Ben spent Saturday afternoon checking out the openers and corkscrews being offered in Don Bull's Auction and said there were a lot of tough openers being offered in the auction. I wrapped up checking his additions, corrections and new discoveries. After supper we got down to a little trading. Ben had a new discovery bottle shaped "Jax Beer" knife and a couple of "B"s. One was from Arlington Brewing Co. in Rosslyn, VA and the other was a B-21-UL West End from Utica, NY. Ben got a B-21-440 Brownsville, a B-13-4 Finks, a C-31-3 P.O.C. and a M-6 Pennsy Pilsener. Ben also gave me an E-25-UL Iroquois and would give me a little more in a future trade.

Larry Moter specializes in "E" type openers and we did some trading. Larry had just bought an E-26-1 Virginia recently. Fil Graff and his wife Robbie were set up and trying to sell his can and bottle collection off. Fil had retired in January and is in the process of selling his house in Chicago and moving to Pennsylvania.

A show open to the public is held on Saturday. I turned up a few more openers but by 12:00 I was ready to head home. In the end I took 20 openers and corkscrews back home to Durham.

## CORKSCREW CELEBRATES 308TH BIRTHDAY

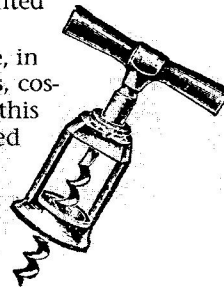
**D**r. Claver Morris may have bought the first corkscrew in 1686. He paid three shillings and sixpence, according to his sales receipt, the first record of a corkscrew's sale.

Not long after that Victorian society raged about the importance of the corkscrew, and the fashionable used only the latest and best.

England had become the country of corkscrews and Birmingham the "Corkscrew Capital of the World," with Manchester just behind. By 1799, inventors had registered 90 patents in Birmingham, 27 in Manchester. By 1819, Birmingham counted 187 corkscrew patents, Manchester 63.

The corkscrew business had become so lucrative, in fact, that businessmen began to advertise medicines, cosmetics, wine and distilled spirits on corkscrews. At this time, apothecaries and perfumers commonly used corks to seal their bottles. Some designed decorative corkscrews for women for these uses. Someone even invented a left-hand cork screw.
