# Spouse's Corner

It is Thursday, December 28, 2000 and John is at work. I have vacation time, so I'm actually writing this during the daytime, rather than the usual late evening hours. I'm not sure if I can write before midnight, but I will give it a try! I will take a break during this composition to go make reservations at the Creature Comfort Inn for Corkie while we are in St. Joe, MO. Since the JFO Convention is the week that begins with Easter Monday, be sure to make arrangements for your little friends now.

The JFO newsletters for 1984 are the highlight this quarter. In '84 Ed Kaye volunteered to carry on as Editor/Publisher of the newsletter while Don Bull went on to do other things, including projects related to his collecting addiction.

Ed was in a merry mood as he wrote the January '84 issue, as he had added opener #2,400 to his collection on December 12<sup>th</sup>, an A-9-4 Leisy.

I'm in a merry mood as I write this article, as I saw the proof for the 2001 Convention Opener yesterday and it is a beauty!!! Don't ask, because I'm sworn to secrecy. As Ollie Hibbeler says, "You Be There!".

On November 12<sup>th</sup>, one month before Ed added his 2400<sup>th</sup> opener, Art Santen celebrated his 50<sup>th</sup> birthday by entering #11,000 to his collection, a new discovery K type Falstaff.

They did something neat for the 1984 Convention. Everyone attending the Convention sent in their want list. The lists were compiled and sent out to everyone registered for the Convention two weeks prior to the great event, so people could bring what others were looking for, if they had the opener for trade/sale. If John thinks that's a good idea, we'll add that to the registration blank, but I think this group has been together for so long, they know what everyone wants. Sometimes they bring them to convention and sometimes they just leave them at home where they enjoy the opener in their own collection and wish the "wisher" the best of luck finding one!

In January, Ed asked people to send in contributions and he did get several responses, some from people I know and others I have not met. Ten members wrote in something to be included in the April '84 newsletter. Your Editor and his spouse certainly welcome input from JFO members!

In 1984, there were 178 members, including, "7 members from our good neighbors in CANADA and 1 from HAWAII". Thanks, Ed...this Canadian appreciates the adjective, "good".

Bob Chapman of the St. Louis Arch Opener Collector Club suggested that they have an auction at the JFO Convention. So, he started that annual event! If you lose a bid, blame it on Chapman!

Don Bull sent in an article for the April '84 issue on the Ten Little Indians (Iroquois) Plus One. Don learned that there were supposedly ten variations of the Iroquois Indian opener made (later he found out there is an 11<sup>th</sup>). He had three. So, what do you think Mr. Bull did? By April 1979, he had seven of them. John, how many little Indians is Bull Sitting on now? Does he have them all, or is he still Running Bull?

If you get snowed/iced in this winter and you have all your collection polished, catalogued and organized in brilliant displays, you may go back to the April '84 issue and solve the puzzle that was included in that issue.

Ollie Hibbeler believed that the St. Louis group "made the most trades & drank the most beer" at the '84 Convention. I doubt anyone would challenge that! The St. Louis group felt that the expense of attending the show was worth it and added, "Besides, think of all the trades you can make now that the flea markets & shows have dried up for any new additions". Now, that statement can be challenged....no more additions???

In the July '84 issue, details about the '84 Convention Opener were shared. This is one convention opener John does not have and regrets very much that it is not in his collection, for all would agree that this was an all time masterpiece. Gary Deachman and Bill McKenzie did a class act with that one.

October '84 issue announced that "The Handbook of Beer Advertising Openers and Corkscrews (An Alphabetical Composite)" authored by Ed Kaye and Don Bull was a reality. Many of those reading this have a treasured, worn copy of this reference book. Larry Sherk did a comprehensive study of Canadian Beer Advertising and published a 28 page catalog of them, containing 112 trackings and 1,100 listings. He had 650 of those openers. Wonder what the stats are today?

An article from the January '80 issue was reprinted in October '84 on the origin of "Church Key". Joe Young, referred to as our "Tin Can Opener Man", shared some additional information on Mr. J.R. Oberhofer, the man who told the story behind this unusual name for an opener. Joe did the research in August '84 to discover that Mr. Oberhofer, Sr. started at the A. Gettelman Brewing Company and returned there after Prohibition. He retired from Miller Brewing Company about 20 years ago (Gettelman was purchased by Miller in 1961). Mr. Oberhofer was a truck driver, and in his later years, worked in the garage. Thanks Tin Can Opener Man! (visit the JFO web site for the complete story)

Don Bull submitted an article on Potlatch for the October '84 issue. On July 17, 1911 Indians started a custom of sharing their treasurers after they had gathered a great supply. This started the custom of "Potlatch". Large firms occupied booths where they gave away small and useful articles publicizing or advertising their products. Seattle Brewing and Malting Company, which then produced Rainier Beer, had such a booth. Every hour they gave away a limited number of beer bottle openers that had a potlatch bug set in enamel and embossed with gold on the handle. People stood in line, sometimes for hours, to get one of these openers, a Type B-11. John has two, previously owned by Bill Ennis.

Sometime in the late 1800's, a calendar salesman, Herbert Bigelow, combined his talents with those of a printer, Hiram Brown, whom he met in the city of St. Paul, Minnesota. Together, as Brown & Bigelow, they produced a wide variety of advertising items, including combination spoon/cap lifters. Their slogan of the past was, "Remembrance Advertising". Today their theme is "The Business Builders", with a plant located in St. Paul.

The October issue also included information on the Tab-E that was to save metal and money. Guess people didn't like the push-in tab, as I've never seen one.

Don Bull also submitted, "The Original Beer Can Opener" for the October issue (see he didn't disappear completely, maybe he had found the other four little Indians and had some time on his hands). This article has everything you ever wanted to know about the punch type can opener.

That article gave me an idea. We will have a trivia quiz at the JFO Convention. The winner will be recognized in some way, not yet determined. John can't enter as he needs to help me design the quiz! We all know that he could easily win otherwise. As long as it's opener related, he has an photographic memory.

In closing, I want to mention that there were contributions from the St. Louis Arch Opener Collector Club throughout 1984. You know those guys, a handful of collectors, fortunate to have others they could meet with throughout the year, continuing the friendships so precious at the annual JFO convention. The death of Vic Keown saddens all JFO members who knew him, and we send extra caring thoughts to the St. Louis group. Since writing the above paragraph, JFO members in the Chicago area are making plans to attend the visitation and/or funeral of Larry Biehl.

The "E-14 Suspect" list started when I sent a much larger list than shown in the last issue to several JFO members who are major collectors of E-14s. These members included Ben Hoffman, Tom Gormally, Larry Moter, John Patton and Verne Vollrath. As a starting point I had used Fred Bolton's want list. He has one of the top E-14 collections and he has thoroughly cataloged each one that he owns. His want list was sent to the above members and they each had openers on the want list. After marking these off of the original list I presented the final "want list" in the last issue.

It was pretty amazing to me, no one had any of the 300 and early 400 numbers listed on the list. Looking back at the original listings when they were made in 1980, a one to one correlation could be made with C-13s listed that year versus the current missing E-14s that were also listed at the same time. I decided these should be deleted and are marked as such above.

Responses to the E-14 list from the last issue were made by the following JFO members, Pete Nowicki, Henry Smith, Mark Barren, Jeff Mahood and Ralph Tewksbury. A couple thought they had one of the missing E-14s, but upon closer inspection it was really one of the ones not on the list. It is probably how these suspect ones were listed in the first place. Henry has a great collection of Cincinnati openers and Mark Barren has a great collection of New York state openers. Figuring if they did not have several of the suspect openers, then they were very likely mis-listed to start with. Most of the non C-13 corrections are from their comments.

The E-14-446 Sunbury was added to the delete list. It should have been included in the last issue, but slipped by. A couple of collectors have this one and it is a true E-9 (with a semi-rounded top). When Bill McKenzie showed E-14 variations in an 1988 July "Opener Trivia" article, his variation E-14a was a really an E-9 variation. Most of these have "Made In U.S.A." stamped across the top of the wire at the opener end. Bill's logic was that they were Post-Pro beer openers and E-9s should be Pre-Pro only. It made sense but was not practical even at that time as most everyone had listed those E-14a variations as E-9s. Of course the reverse was true and some had been listed as E-14s and in the years just after 1988 I am sure several more have been added to the E-14s when they are really E-9s. As John Patton proved to me they can exist as both E-9s and E-14s. I believe at this point, if serious local collectors have not found the E-14 style then it probably does not exist.

Thank you to everyone who responded to my requests. Just remember what has been deleted today can be added back tomorrow if someone is lucky enough to find one of the "Suspect E14s". In the future I will probably clean the list up even further and I will keep everyone abreast of anymore deletions.

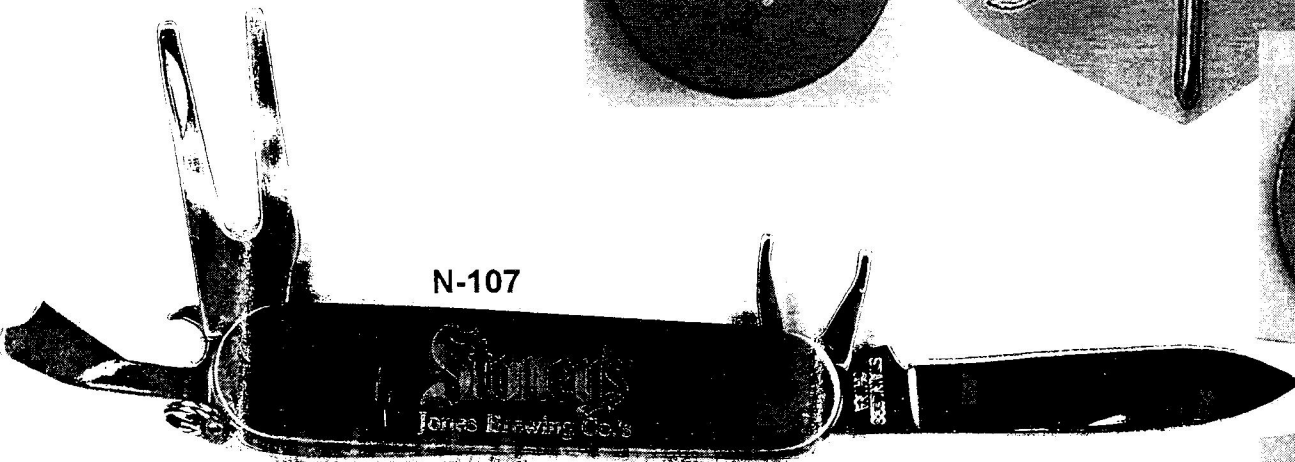
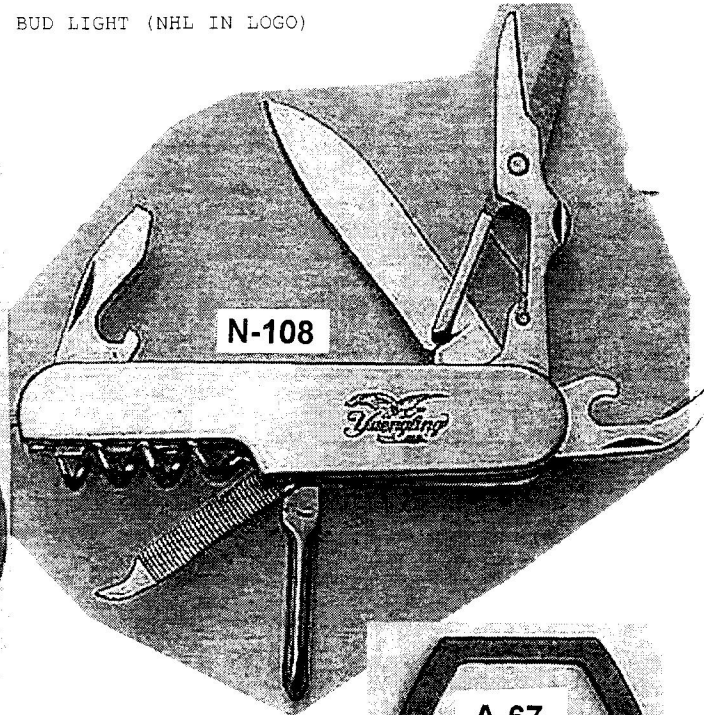
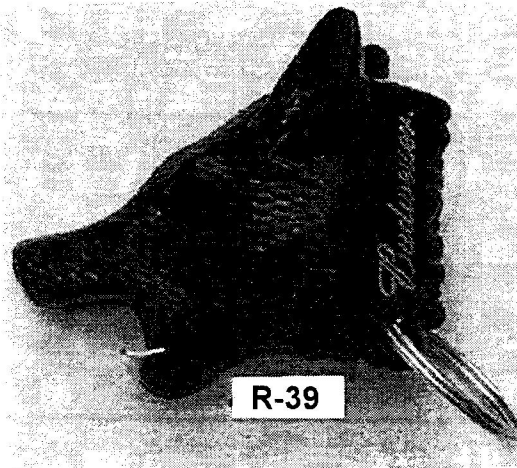

One of the highlights had to be the Harley-Davidson Motorcycle spinner opener. The first I have seen on the market and brought a nice price at \$430. The A-22 Balantine was another highly desirable figural bringing a final price of \$210.39. The H-9 Schlitz & Barmann was mentioned on page 2 and is probably the only beer one known for this type. Slide-out corkscrews have continued to stay hot (check out the M-73-14 story below) along with hard to find O-5s, the Glasco Cooler having been offered before on eBay and brought about the same price as this one. Major brand soda openers always seem to do well and sometimes despite continually be offered on eBay. The Dr. Pepper bullet pencil (N-29) has been offered between 12 to 15 times and lowest price I have seen is \$135 and the highest being \$350 with most bringing \$200-250. If you are not signed up you better start thinking about it. After this year's convention Bob Stahly got on the band wagon and as he put it, "I have found more openers on eBay in six months that I have in the last few years combined". Bob has filled quite a few holes in his collection. Sure the competition can be stiff, but if you love openers you will love eBay.

From the last issue, Ollie Hibbeler's very unusual Coca-Cola wall mount opener brought this response from Bob Stahly. They were made in the late 50's by A. J. Hunt and Son in Kangley, Illinois, which is a suburb of Streator. The Hunts were only in business for a short time. They also made 6 Down, Crescent Moon and Dr. Moore, among the many wall mount openers. They had to close down because Coca-Cola sued them for making the opener you have, since it wasn't authorized by them. The Hunts didn't have the money to fight the suit. Therefore, because it wasn't an authorized opener, it is worthless. Even so, I would still give you \$10.00 for it. Thank you Bob for shedding light on this "worthless" opener, I guess I can sneak a bid in for \$11.00. Anyone else interested?

Just as the October issue was going out, Dave Pinney and Jeb Burruss locked in a battle on eBay for a M-73-14 Budweiser and Becker slide-out corkscrew that also advertised Pinney Beverage Company of Salt Lake City, Utah. The owner of Pinney Beverage Company was none other than Dave's father. I guess no matter how much Jeb was going to bid, Dave wanted this opener and was successful at \$265.00 (not exactly sure but this figure is real close). Dave is going to get more history from his 95 year mother but did provide me with the following information about the Pinney Beverage Company.

My father, Kenneth J. Pinney, purchased the Jess C. Olsen Distributing Co. and in 1931 organized Pinney Beverage Co. at 533 South Fourth West in Salt Lake City, Utah. Since prohibition was still in place the company sold Becker's Becco near beer and White Rock soda waters. With the lifting of prohibition on December 5, 1933 the company added Becker's Beer, Budweiser Beer and Uinta Club Beer. The company sponsored several sports teams and the baseball team developed into the heart of the AA league Salt Lake City Bees. My father was killed in an auto accident in April, 1950. My mother continued in business until 1955 when Budweiser decided that a woman couldn't operate a beer distributorship and gave the franchise to a man. The business folded in six months.

Dave is always looking for any items from Pinney Beverage Co. Besides the M-73 he has an N-9 openers, bottle resealer. Check out his want ad and thanks very much for the story, Dave.

### "Opener Trivia" (Continued)

It is always interesting to find patent on an opener. The following patent information on an M-78 opener. The opener is marked "Pat. April 14, 1914 Hesuah." I would assume Hesuah is the manufacturer's name since the patent is assigned to L. Kalina. With the drawing is the following write-up:

#### Information on Patent 1,093,432

Mr. Kalina states: "The object of the invention is to provide a new and improved combination tool embracing a key ring, scissors, button hook, cigar cutter, and bottle opener, and arranged to take up very little space when the several devices are in folded position, thus allowing of conveniently carrying the combination tool in a vest pocket."

In Fig. 3, the slanting slit (C) in ring (A) forms the key ring. The outer edge (D) in conjunction with the crossbar (B) provide an opener for bottle caps.

The scissors pivots on pin (E), and has an opening (H3) adapted to engage pin (F) when the scissors is to be kept in a closed position.

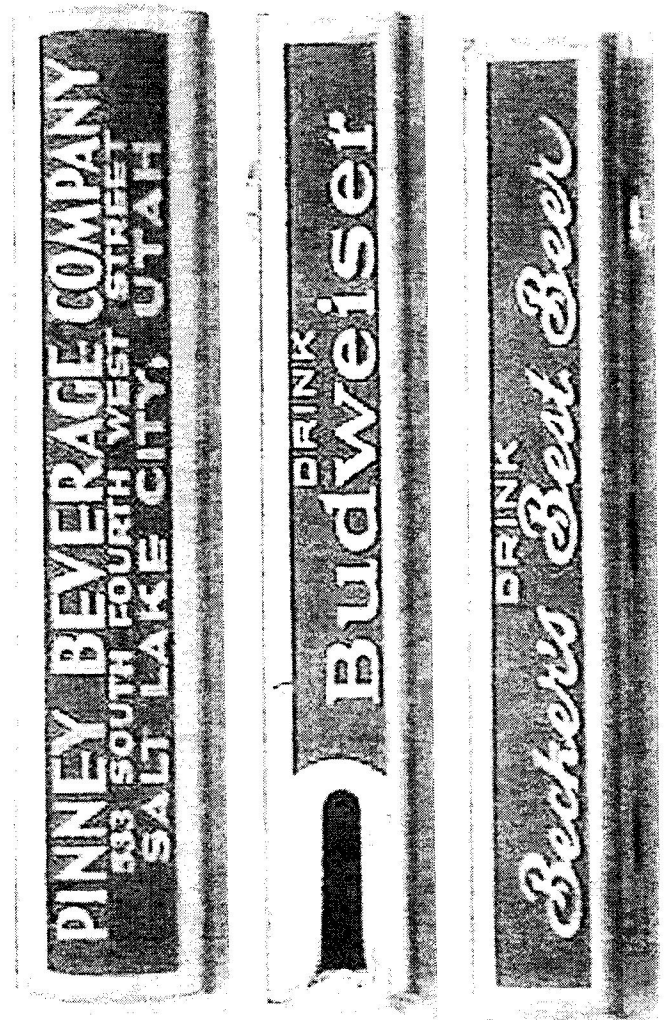
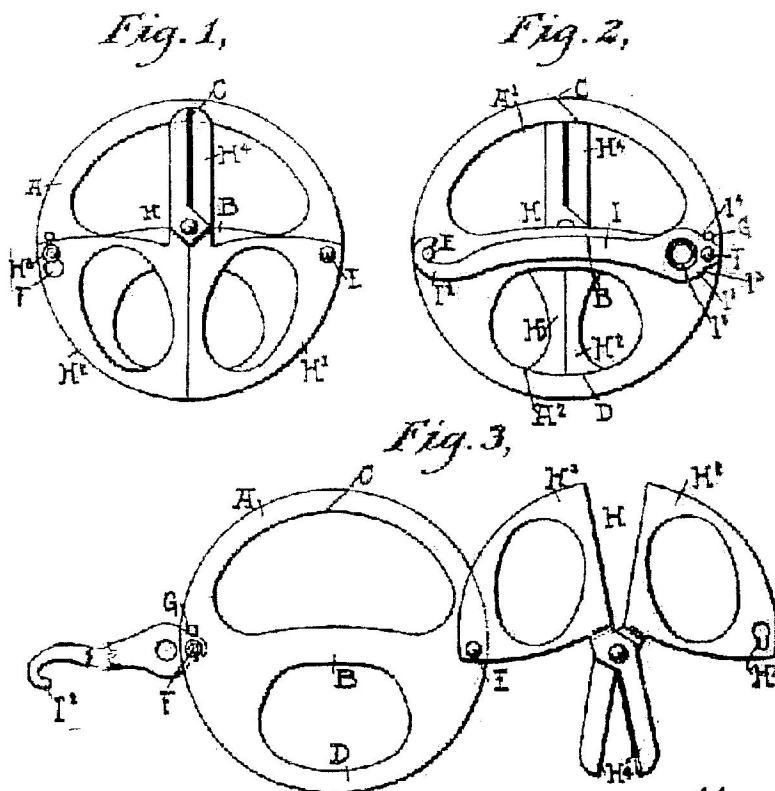
A button hook is adapted to overlie the other face of ring (A), as in Fig. 2. The end of the shank pivots on the projecting end of pin (F), and the hook engages the projecting end of pin (E).

These ends have different letters in Fig. 2. The end of the shank is provided with a round opening (1,5) having a beveled wall. When the buttonhook is swung open one can insert the tip of a cigar into the round opening. Swinging the shank in either direction will cut the tip off the cigar.
