

Just for Openers



Do you know? - Apparently not! There were no responses to Del Haarberg's and E. Royal Gage's questions in issue #2. Regarding The Gutsch Brewing Company opener: Winifred Reutter reports - "Ask any old miner or cowboy - it's a beer or bean can opener. Hold the opener upright with end point on center of can and pound on round end with palm of hand to punch hole. Leaving tip in hole, lay opener down, adjust sliding point to inside can rim, press down and turn around and around." Winifred says here husband has seen old cowboys use it. She has an opener like it with a wooden handle. Similar answers were reported by Gene Appel, Andy Growe, and Bill McKenzie.

Don Reed has come up with an interesting study of the cost of his collection of 1840 beer advertising openers. The total cost through March was \$3,613.58 and Don's purchase record looks like this:

Collector Opens Show For Fans Of Openers

Art Santen goes on unusual hunting trips on Sundays. Instead of hunting in the forest with a rifle, he stalks flea markets, garage and rummage sales, and antique shops.

His prey — bottle, corkscrew and can openers.

Santen sponsored the first Bottle, Can and Corkscrew Openers Convention on Sunday at St. Roch's Catholic Church, 6052 Waterman Boulevard.

"This is the first trade show we have ever had," said Santen, of 6126 McPherson Avenue. "The convention is only for people interested in trading bottle, can and corkscrew openers."

During the last four years, Santen has collected 3,700 openers from all over the world.

"I became interested in collecting openers when my father-in-law four years ago gave me some old St. Louis brewery can openers," Santen said. "I then picked up different kinds of openers — shims, dolls, spoons and keys — and put them in my basement on 2-foot-square boards."

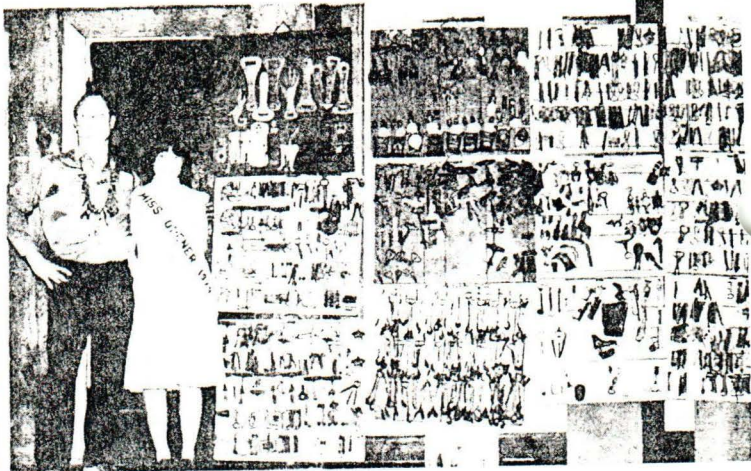
After meeting with several persons who collect openers, Santen said, he decided to sponsor the first trade show convention for collectors interested in can, bottle and corkscrew openers.

But only seven persons attended the trade show, where Santen had the largest display. He had about 30 boards of openers covering an entire wall in the basement of the church.

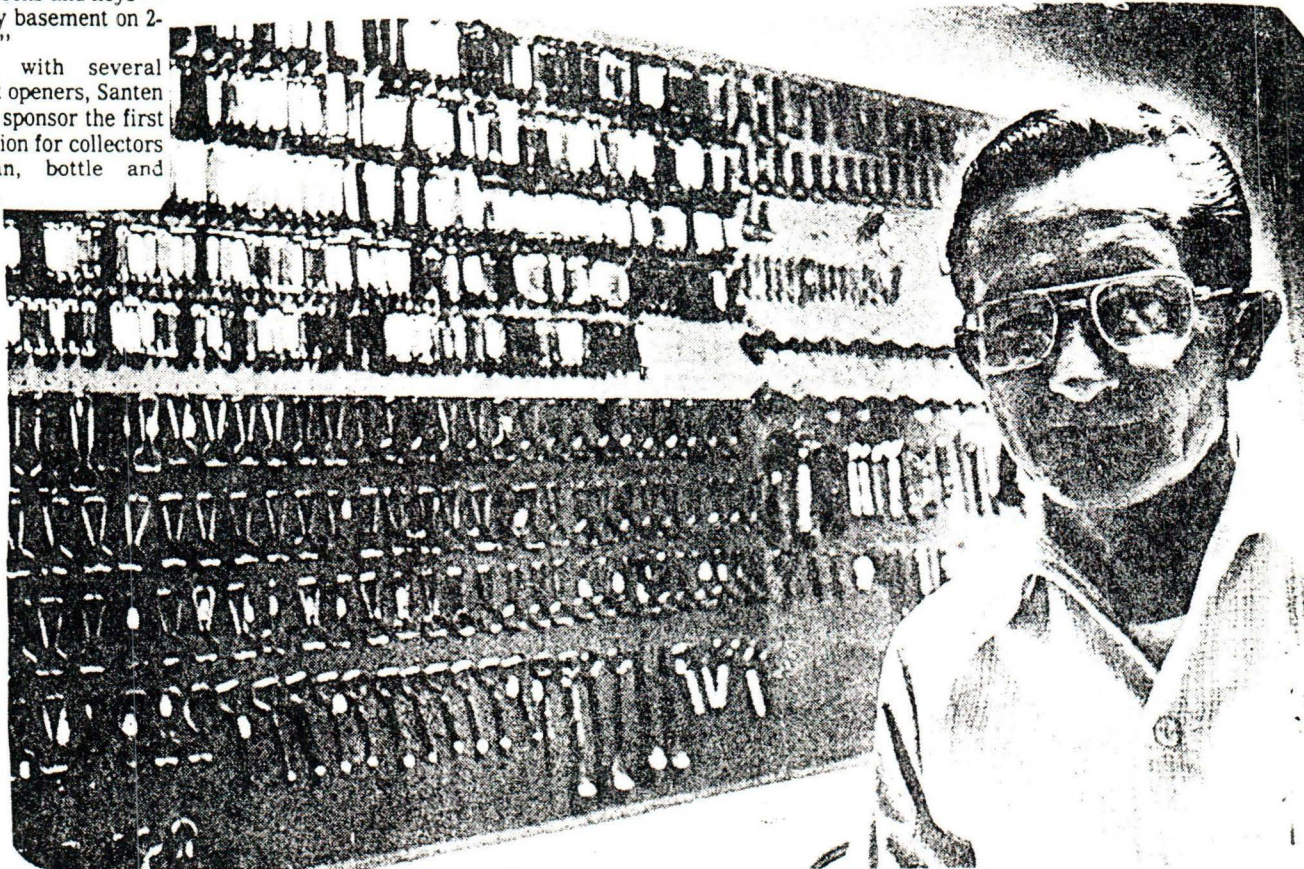
On display were can openers of various sizes and shapes from foreign countries, including South Africa, Russia, Korea, Mexico, Pakistan, Panama, Peru and Holland. One can opener was shaped like the key to Vatican City.

"I've never been to any of these countries, but usually I can find openers in antique shops and get them from people who travel," Santen said.

He was wearing a necklace made of openers that included a clown's head, whiskey bottle and fur. He also wore a regular bottle and can opener with a red and white handle that advertised the convention and was given out to the few visitors there.

Page 8. The openers on the top half (hold Horizontal) of this page are foreign beer advertising openers. The knife with the Harp on it is from Guinness. On the bottom half of the page are a number of interesting miscellaneous openers. Thanks to Dennis Murphy, Andy Grove, and Bob Carter for their contributions here. The Overbrook Co. retractable is twice as wide as the type M-3 and has a corkscrew inside. The opener to the right of the Cigar opener is a cousin of the K-3 Rheingold - it is marked "Krueger."



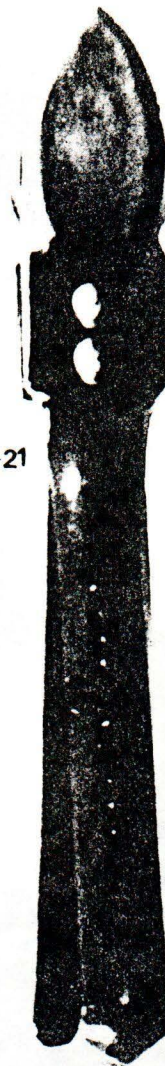

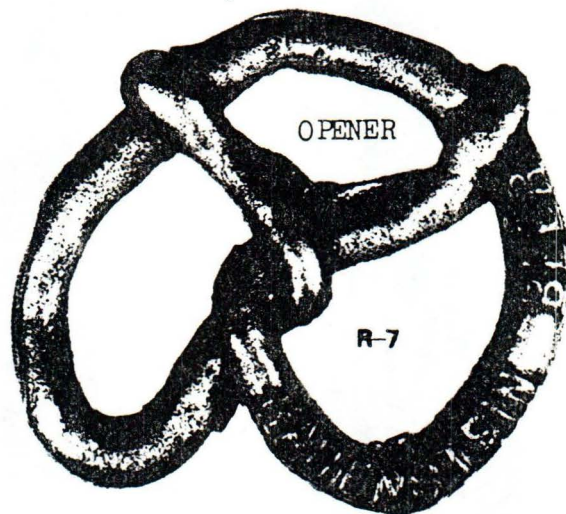

AN AMERICAN ART FORM

It was after World War II that a novelty item, the figural bottle opener, came into it's own. Although a few were made and patented before that time, this item was in it's heyday circa 1950. They were made as a one dollar novelty, as a fraternity/sorority favor, and as advertising.

I have pictured four openers that have more than passing interest. Second from the left is the lamp post drunk - probably the most common opener, still in production today, and made in countless variations by a number of manufacturers. Since design patents did not hold up too well, a slight change (e.g. leg up or down; street sign versus lamp post) allowed almost anyone to produce this opener. My current information is that this was the first figural opener produced by John Wright, Inc., and, therefore, may have been the first produced by anyone. The opener on the left depicts a black boy being nipped by an alligator. The boy with the pledge paddle is an item sold by "Gadzik" - a firm in Philadelphia. Similar items were also made by L & L Favors. John Wright Co. poured the metal and did the painting for both firms. The parrot shown is the most interesting of this theme of openers. This one opens the bottle by means of a hook at the base of the stand, whereas the other figural parrot openers use their beaks as openers.

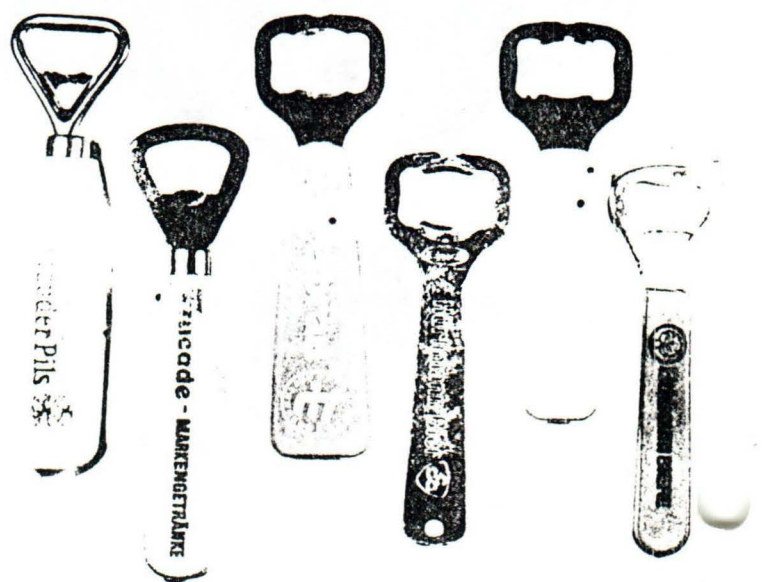
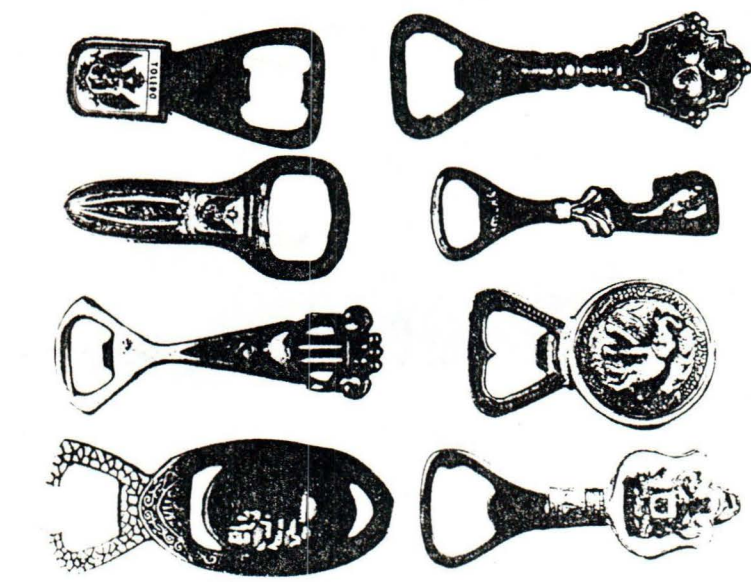
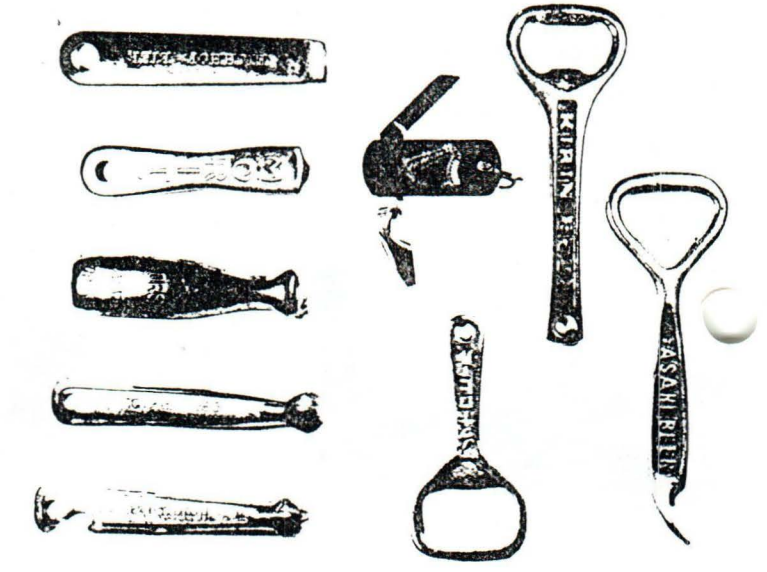
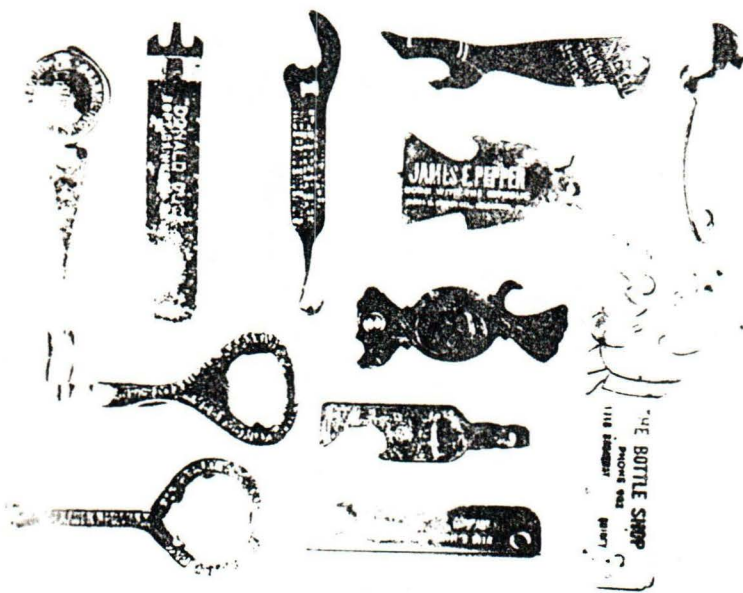
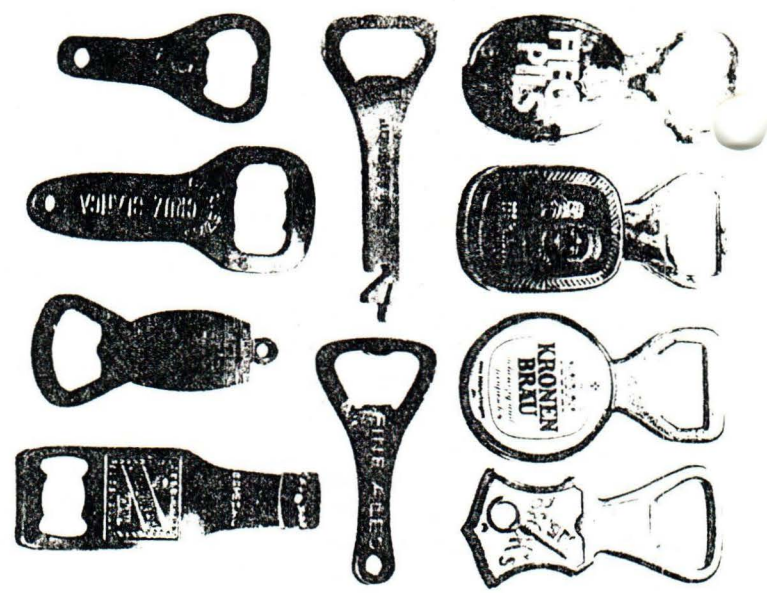
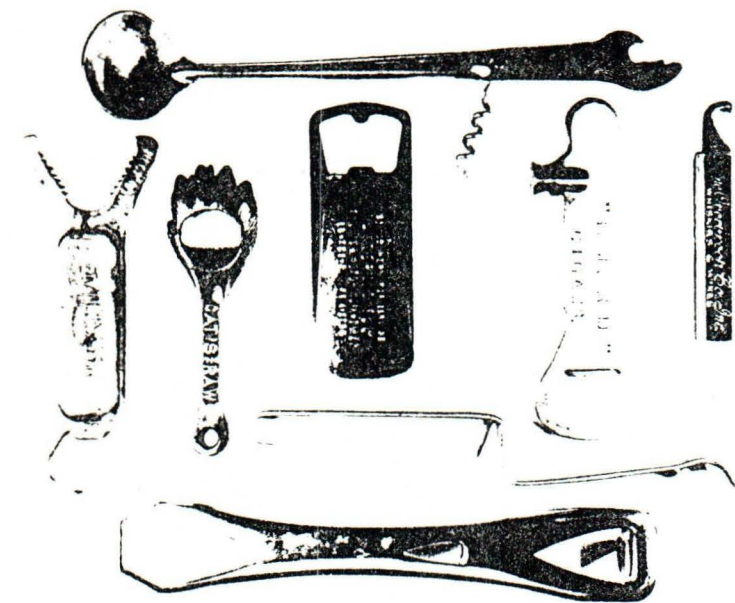
